If requested, these landscapers will use native plants in their landscape designs. It can be difficult to find a landscaper that knows about local native plants. Many landscapers consider plants from other eco-regions, states, and countries to be native; so tell the landscaper if you would prefer to use native plants that are truly native to your area. Native plants are part of local ecosystems and they are essential to the survival of native life forms. Native plants are low maintenance and require little water, fertilizer, or pesticides once established.
